14. Discussion and decision on contracting with the county to remove car killed deer. The towns were presented with the following information. They are offering to remove the car kill deer in the municipality until June 1st, 2019. The cost for the service would be \$108.53 per year billed on the July invoice.
There is a new CKD removal process in its final steps. As of March 1st all municipalities are responsible for keeping their own local roads safe and clear of road hazards. The DNR will continue to coordinate car killed deer pickup and disposal services on interstate, U.S. and state highways. Under this new system Statute (2015-17 budget) – Wis. Stat. s. 29.349 now allows for possession and removal of a deer carcass from the scene of an accident once an individual notifies the DNR and provides their name, address, and the carcass lotion. This notification must be completed BEFORE taking possession or removing the carcass from the scene. CKD are no longer required to be tagged by a law enforcement officer. In any circumstance where an individual wants to take possession of a car-killed deer, staff/dispatchers should refer the caller to contact the DNR at 608/297-7691.
NOTE: Car-killed bear and turkey must still be tagged by a law enforcement officer in accordance with prior procedures through TraCS generated car-kill tags or DNR issued tags.
