9. Open Book and Board of Review Dates were on Friday April 26th from 5:00-7:00 and Board of Review was on Friday May 10th from 6:00-8:00 p.m.
10. The board discussed designating a spot for sand and salt mix for the upcoming winter and for placement of horse and buggy parking area. The mix will be inside the fence at the recycle center with a barrel outside for easy access. The board is going to look in to building the horse and buggy hitching rail in the designated parking area.
11. The chairman reviewed the Fireworks permit for Wilderness campground and approved and the Chairman signed it.
12. The board is looking for help to fix the flower bed in front of the town hall. Kyle Kidney offered his help.
13. The Town board signed a resolution to take over 3 of the cemeteries in the township. More information will be coming.
14. Road construction will start in the middle of April in the Montello area.
15. They cut 12 miles of brush along the town roads.

The Board will review the request for the following and make a recommendation to the Board of Appeals. **Mark & Lori Murphy**, N712 16th Rd, Pardeeville, WI 53954 are requesting Variances under Sections 16.05(2)(C) and 16.13(3) of the Town of Buffalo Zoning Ordinance for construction of a garage to replace an existing legal non-conforming garage at a reduced setback to a lot line and the centerline of a town road on Lot 1 and part of Lot 2, CSM 1783, in the SW1/4-NE1/4, Section 27, T14N R10E, **Town of Buffalo.** Fire # **N712 16th Rd.**
