NEW BUSINESS

The Board reviewed the bid from David Henke for mowing the town roads. Bid is for a total of \$6562.00 for clean up and ditch mowing in the township. The first mow will be done by July 1st and the 2nd will be done by October 1st. There were no other bids for mowing. Motion from Roger Wallis to approve the bid. Second from Jan Banicki.

Scott Zuehls from Marquette County ATV club spoke regarding request to link the ATV road trail that goes though Town of Buffalo to get to a new local business on Highway B. They are looking at adding the horseshoe from Gillette Rd to connect to Grand Avenue. They are trying to stay off of Hwy B as much as possible. Fred Wollenburg asked why they can't extend from Lovers Lane to Hwy B. That is only 1 mile from the Restaurant. Joel Burbach spoke of problems on Hwy F. Tires are very noisy. He feels that there are many violations. He likes the peace and quiet. Joel showed articles regarding noise. He stated that in the past when the ATV trails were talked about the people did not want it. He understands that people want to ride. Please ride around your own homes. Believes ATVs are good for farming. ATVs are not quiet. Need to do things by design.

Fred Wollenburg Wondering why the people from Green Lake County need to come thru Buffalo to get to Green Lake County. This is no benefit to The Town of Buffalo.

Jan Banicki stated that when anything is moved forward-the people need to come and voice their own opinion. Scott stated that there will be more discussion at a later time regarding any more trails. The request tonight is for only a ½ mile to connect their route.

Scott Kempley made a motion to open the connecting horseshoe from Grand Ave around to Gillette Rd. Second by Roger Wallis.

IN FAVOR-3 OPPOSED-0 MOTION CARRIED

This is not in force until added to the Ordinance and the roads are posted. Watch for postings.

The Board started looking over the bids for the road repairs in the Township. There were bids from Marquette County for the TRI Program which is Gem Rd East of 14th CT for 2640' and also for Gem Road West of STH 22, Gillette Drive-East of CTH F, 13th-14th Rd to Gillette Ave Gillette Ave-13th Rd to Gravel Section at end, Golden Rd-Grouse Rd to Curve West of RxR Tracks-12th Ave-County Line to Mat Change south of CT Hwy O and 17th Road-CTH O to STH 22 - 1.4 miles.

Bids were also received from DL Gasser, Fahrner, and Scott Construcion. The board discussed and decided to have another special meeting to review the bids closer to make a final decision. Decided to call a Special meeting for June 15th at 6:00 p.m.
