OLD BUSINESS

The board gave an update on the Routes to Recover Funding. The money will reimburse for the purchase of the protective shields in the town hall used for elections, for the air purifiers and for installation of the new exit door. The board stated that any money left should go to the County and the school district if that was possible.

NEW BUSINESS

The board discussed the flooding issues on Barry Road. Scott stated that it is not our township but that things are being taken care of.

The board discussed doing some more road brushing. There was good input from David Rieckman regarding concerns with doing more brushing. The board appreciated the good citizen input on the brushing. Things will be assessed before doing.

The election went along smoothly-there were 640 voters.

CITIZEN AND BOARD CONCERNS

The Clerk stated that the Town of Marcelon is requesting to get on the Agenda to discuss possible connecting routes for the ATV Trail. The board was notified and all meetings will be posted. There was concern stated regarding the Gem Rd Ditch again. The board is still working on this issue.

Joel Burbach stated that there are bare spots and it is really rough where the road work was done on Gillette North of John Muir Park. David Reickman stated that there are also potholes between 15th and Gem that need to be repaired. The board decided to invite Brian Trebiatowski to the December meeting.

Both the Clerk and the Treasurer stated that they were in need of new printers. Both are having printer issues and will need to be replaced.
