OLD BUSINESS

The board gave update on work done on Barry Road-Work to address water issue. The charges for the work was split between Town of Buffalo and Town of Marcelon. Buffalo share was a little over \$2000.

The board asked Brian Trebaitowski for an estimate for doing a guardrail on Gem Rd. Brian Spoke regarding the guardrail and the situation. The estimate to install a guardrail would be \$24,500. The board discussed situation.

The Routes to Recovery funding for the COVID 19 expenses has been paid out. All items submitted were covered.

NEW BUSINESS

The board discussed the Rezone request from Peter Steuck. Motion by Roger Wallis to approve the request as recommended from the Land Use Commission. Second by Jan Banicki.

Roger Wallis read the new Ordinance and the Board signed with the Clerk as witness.

Brian Trebaitowski spoke on snow plowing in the township. He answered many citizen and board questions. He was asked what triggers snow plowing. When the County trucks go out the town roads will be done also. Brian gave reports on the usage of sand/salt mix and plain sand. He did cost comparisons and explained the choice on what to use. He gave very detailed information on the process of plowing-road assignments and the usage of sand/salt-sand. All drivers start at 4:00 am as needed. There are 2 drivers assigned to the Town of Buffalo.

The board reviewed the end of year bills for 2020 -Only checks to do yet would be end of year payroll for recycling center and the Treasurers end of year mileage.

Citizens were told to watch for their property tax bills-Please read insert completely.
