Mobile Parks Ordinance #3: Discussion on the proposed ordinance. Mr. Church will revise it and bring it back to the board at the next meeting.

2004 Proposed Budget: Budget was reviewed in detail. There will be a meeting in November to set the budget for 2004.

Assessor Contract: Sandy James was present and discussed our options. We will wait until the November meeting to sign contract.

St. Andrew's Cemetery: The board passed a resolution to accept the St. Andrew's Cemetery plat as proposed by Grothman and Associates. Motion by Jan Banicki. Seconded by Phyllis Farrell.
