**February 9, 2004**

Meeting was called to order by Jan Banicki. 18 citizens were present. Meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance. Gene Mucciolo was sworn in as the new chairman.

Minutes were read from the January meeting. Motion by Jan Banicki (seconded by Phyllis Farrell) to accept minutes as presented.

Treasurer's report was given. Motion by Jan Banicki (seconded by Phyllis Farrell) to accept the report as presented.

**Candidates for April County Seats Election:** Mike Miller, Bob Miller, and Jerome Herrick were present to introduce themselves to the public. All are running for seats on the County Board in the April election. All gave short introductions on themselves and answered any questions the citizens had.

**Election Board:** It was discussed if people working on the Elections Committee who attend trainings at the County should be paid since the Board has asked them to attend these trainings. They currently are not paid. We are one of two townships in the county that do not pay people to attend the trainings. This matter was tabled for future discussion.

**Uniform Dwelling Code:** Discussion was held on the upcoming Uniform Dwelling Code (UDC). Gene will look into this matter more and report back at the next meeting. Jan Banicki motioned (Gene Mucciolo seconded) to table this item for more needed information.

**Buffalo Hills Road:** Gene gave update on information he has received to date. The road will be looked at in the spring when there is no snow and ice to see condition of the road. Motion by Jan Banicki (seconded by Gene Mucciolo) to table until inspection of the road can be done.

**Town Website:** A website address has been obtained for the township. Gene and Becki will work to get the site up and going.

**Citizens/Board Concerns:** The following items were brought to the attention of the board as concerns by citizens: brushing on roads, signs blocking view of oncoming road traffic, plowing, wayside, and the Land Use Planning Committee.

**Vouchers:** Vouchers were presented and a motion was made by Jan Banicki (seconded by Phyllis Farrell) to pay said vouchers.

Business Concluded. Motion to adjourn by Jan Banicki (seconded by Gene Mucciolo). Motion carried.
