Chairman called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

Treasurer's report was given. Jan Banicki motioned to accept the report. Seconded by Fred Wollenburg. All in favor, motion carried.

Review of Proposed Ordinances: Clerk will run the Resolution to Publish Ordinances again in the paper again in late February. There was no discussion on the said ordinances.

Tax Bills: Treasurer discussed the Mobile Home Parking Permit Fees collected in 2004. She also gave the chairman a letter for Robert Liebeltd regarding his 2003 tax bill. There was a discussion on how to handle tax overpays/underpays. A motion was made Gene Mucciolo that all overpayments under \$10 will be kept by the town in a tax surplus fund. All underpayments under \$1 will be paid out of the tax surplus fund. Motion seconded by Jan Banicki. All in favor, motion carried. This will be effective immediately.

Petition to Abandon Road, Norm Roberts: Chairman brought to the boards attention the Public Hearing that will be held on March 14, 2005 regarding a petition we received by Norm Roberts to abandon a road.

Citizen and Board Concerns: Update was given on the Emergency Planning Meeting. Update was given on the Uniform Dwelling Code. Update on the Room Tax in Marquette County.

Clerk brought to board's attention that the heater is not safe to run due to a leaky valve. An alternative heat source will be found for the election workers tomorrow. A motion was made by Gene Mucciolo to spend up to \$250 on an alternative heat source if needed. Seconded by Jan Banicki. All in favor, motion carried. Parts have been ordered to fix the furnace.

Vouchers: Checks were presented and a motion was made by Jan Banicki to pay said bills. Seconded by Gene Mucciolo. All in favor, motion carried.

Business Concluded. Motion to adjourn by Jan Banicki. Seconded by Fred Wollenburg. Motion carried.
