

## **Town Meeting for the Town of Buffalo**

### **March 14, 2005**

Chairman called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance. Supervisor Jan Banicki was absent from the meeting.

Agenda was reviewed and approved by the board.

Minutes were read. Fred Wollenburg motioned to accept the minutes. Seconded by Gene Mucciolo. All in favor, motion carried.

Treasurer's report was given. Gene Mucciolo motioned to accept the report. Seconded by Fred Wollenburg. All in favor, motion carried.

Petition to Abandon Road, Norm Roberts: Petition was read by the clerk. Attorney Doug Kammer answered any questions there were. A motion was made by Gene Mucciolo to accept said petition. Seconded by Fred Wollenburg. All in favor, motion carried.

Town Newsletter: A newsletter will be handed out at the April election and at the Annual Meeting. Items to discuss are: recycling center being open on Wednesday's and the Uniform Dwelling Code.

Review of Proposed Ordinances: Gene reviewed and answered questions regarding the proposed ordinances. A motion was made by Gene Mucciolo to change the effective date from March 1 to March 16 in the Land Division/Subdivision Ordinance. Seconded by Fred Wollenburg. All in favor, motion carried. All ordinances become effective March 16, 2005. Gene Mucciolo will notify county of the ordinances.

Fire District Meeting Report: Gene Mucciolo gave an update from the recent Fire District Meeting. The fire department has concerns with townships billing individuals for fire calls. They are receiving a lot of complaints from individuals. This will be brought up at the Annual Meeting. Town chair has discussed concerns he has with the accounting at the fire department level. He has asked them for a more formal report.

Recycling Center: Large item pick-up will be on April 23 with Mark Cupery. Prices are the same as last year. The recycling center will again be open on Wednesday's starting the first Wednesday in April.

Uniform Dwelling Code: Tom Onofrey with the county is setting up a meeting with the Amish to discuss how the Uniform Dwelling Code will affect them. A tentative date of March 28 is set.

Emergency Management Plan Status: A brief update was given. Gene Mucciolo is looking for grants that will help us.

Planning Committee: The next planning meeting was set for March 30 at 7 p.m. at the Town Hall.

Annual Meeting Agenda: The date for the next annual meeting was set for April 12, 2005 at 7 p.m. Items to add to the agenda are Recreation and Election Worker wages.

Correspondence: Letters were received from the DNR and Medicare. Letters were sent to Montello Schools regarding the Mobile Home Parking Permit fees and we also sent out the 2003 chargeback forms.
