Revision to Chapter 8 – Citation Ordinance

Ordinance Violations

- c. Mike Gard of W4002 County O has not corrected his violation even though he was granted an extension.
- d. Mike Bilberry property on Ridge Road has multiple junk cars that are in violation.

Plan Committee Report from February 27th meeting

- a. Alma (Bunny) Paul Minor Land Division Application – The Plan Commission has reviewed the CSM and recommends their approval to the Town Board. Fred Wollenburg, seconded by Jan Banicki, makes a motion to approve the CSM for the Alma Paul Minor Land Division Application. Discussion followed. All in favor, motion carried.
- b. Wayne and Mary Hunter Minor Land Division Request – The Plan Commission explained the procedure and that they needed to provide a CSM for the application.
- c. County Zoning -- Fred Wollenburg reported that the County has received our input concerning the proposed zoning changes. Zoning plans to have another meeting by the end of March 2007.

Correspondence

- a. Marquette County Land & Water Conservation Department – The 2007 budget for the Recycling Grant will be the same or less than 2006. All the towns are asked to “think of ways to decrease your recycling cost.” Discussion followed. The next Large Item Recycling will be Saturday, May 12, 2007.
- b. WisLink Classes are available.

Citizens and Board Concerns

- a. Jan Banicki will contact the Sheriff's Department to see if they can attend the April 10th Annual Meeting to address the issues of burn barrels, shining, and ATVs in Muir Park. Discussion followed.
- b. Town Hall Furnace – The current furnace leaks propane now and will be too costly to repair. Johnson Bros. Heating and Cooling submitted a bid for \$2900 and will have the new furnace installed before the April election. The closet on the right of the door will be converted into a furnace room. Fred Wollenburg, seconded by Jan Banicki, made a motion to approve the installation of a new furnace for \$2900 by Johnson Bros. Heating and Cooling and approve material and labor by David Seddon to construct the furnace room to Johnson Bros. specifications. Discussion followed. All in favor, motion carried.
- c. Town Well –February 20th the County Highway Department plowed the parking lot and they hit the well damaging the cement pad, the well casing and cap. The Highway Department will be contacted about damage. Discussion followed. The Board would like to contact plumbers to have the well evaluated to see if it should be sealed or improved. Bids will be requested for the work to be done.
- d. Signage at Muir Park – The County will be contacted regarding signage that addressed no ATVs in the park. Discussion followed.

Vouchers

Checks were presented and discussed. Jan Banicki, seconded by Gene Mucciolo, made a motion to pay said vouchers. All in favor, motion carried.
