Road Work—TRIP Fund Road Bid-Grand Avenue

We have to submit a Prevailing Wage request to the State. The description is: Paving of Grand Avenue starting at the Green Lake County Line to SW Grand Avenue east and ending after the intersection of west 18th Road. The road will be marked with paint and is approximately 1.01

miles. We are requesting 2” of overlay and 18” graveled shoulders. Charlie Church will check with Ben Bult on the language for the bid request.

1. Fox Drive needs patching of pot holes and gravel.
2. Gillette Road past turner’s is gravel that needs to be maintained.
3. The sharp corner on 14th needs repair and there is a hole in the culvert on 14th by Ron Kerl’s place.
4. 17th has a hole in the culvert at W2856.
