Ordinance #18.2 Amended 8/19/2013—Ordinance to Lower Speed Limit on Town Highways.

Some of the concerns were tourism; speeding vehicles; roads that cannot be traveled at 55 mph; safety hazards to bikers, hikers, kids and Amish; drivers should use common sense when traveling Town roads; maintenance of signs would be too costly; and the Sheriff will not be able to police roads to stop speeders.
