Scott Kempley, second by Jean Rataczak, made a motion for John Goetz to act as vote counter of the caucus. 31 – Aye and 0 – Nay. All in favor, motion carries.

Charles Church called for nominations for Town Chairperson.

Roger Banicki, second by Bob Brockway, made a motion to nominate Charles Corso for Town Chairman.

The chairman called for nomination three times. No other nominations were presented. Mary-Anne Raab, second by Jan Banicki, made a motion to close the nominations for Town Chairperson. 31– Aye and 0 – Nay. All in favor, motion carries.

Mary-Anne Raab, second by Shane Dedrick, made a motion to nominate Ryan McReath for Town Supervisor.

Richard Rygiewicz, second by Roger Banicki, made a motion to nominate Laura Rygiewicz for Town Supervisor.

Mary-Anne Raab, second by David Seddon, made a motion to nominate Donna Seddon for Town Supervisor.

Fred Wollenburg, second by Karen Wollenburg, made a motion to nominate David Larkin for Town Supervisor.

The chairman called for nominations three times. No other nominations were presented. Karen Wollenburg, second by David Seddon, made a motion to close the nominations for Town Supervisor. 32– Aye and 0 – Nay. All in favor, motion carries.

Caucus rules only allow four (4) supervisor nominees for the ballot in April. The vote counters passed out slips of paper to all residents. The clerk instructed the residents that they should vote for two (2) nominees for supervisor. The four nominees with the most votes will have their names on the April ballot. The vote counters collected the slips of paper and tallied the votes. The totals are as follows:

The chairman called for nominations three times. No other nominations were presented. Fred Wollenburg, second by Jan Banicki, made a motion to close the nominations for Town Treasurer. 32 – Aye and 0 – Nay. All in favor, motion carries.
