Discussion on the Highway Department looking at changing speed limit before and after John Muir Park. Citizens expressed concern about intersection of Hwy F & Hwy O. Asking if maybe lower speed limit could be extended that far. Jan Banicki reported that there will be one wedding held at the park this year as well as other events. There is a problem with parking and the number of cars coming in and leaving. The highway department is taking all of this in to consideration.

Charles Corso mentioned that it would be nice if people would not plow snow on to their neighbors property.

Mention of the upcoming meetings on January 28th for a rezone request and to review the 9 chapters of the comprehensive plan.

Citizens & Boards concerns. Ryan McReath reported about the sign that was put up at John Muir park regarding gasoline motors. The sign is being changed to more clearly state the intent of the sign.

Jan Banicki spoke on Parks & Rural Planning. There will be a meeting regarding the Wayside Park on Hwy 22. She asked if people would like the wayside left open during the winter months. Jan stated that there has been damage caused during the winter months. Marianne Hanson asked if it would cost the town anything additional to have it stay open. Jan stated that it is no additional cost to the town. Marianne Hanson & Scott Kempley both agreed that it should stay open.
