The Board voted in April to move \$25,000 from the non-designated general fund to the Fire Fund for the new Fire Truck. The Fire truck will be purchased in 2019. The board also voted to move the full \$125,000.00 in to a CD.

Charles Corso mentioned that the Pot hole filling is done

Charles Corso also stated that all of the roads are rated by the County.

Charles Corso checked in to grants for the township. The County takes care of the grants and they will notify us if there is anything available.

NEW BUSINESS

Charles Corso & Jan Banicki did the road tour with Randy Ravenscroft. Charles Corso read the roads that will be addressed. The Board has received a bid of \$45,200.00 to do what is needed to be done. Charles Corso explained to Randy Ravenscroft that they cannot go over the estimate. Roger Wallis made a motion to accept the bid and to approve it per the dollar amount of the quote.

The Chairman Charles Corso stated that the Wilderness Campground has applied for a fireworks permit. Jan Banicki made a motion to approve the permit. Second by Roger Wallis.

Charles Corso informed the citizens that there have been complaints about people trespassing on private property. The board will check in to this and see what can be done.

The board discussed the horses and buggies in the township and the waste dropping. The Board is checking in to ways to help take care of this. This item will be tabled until the board gets more information.

Charles Corso explained that Hwy 22 in the year 2020 or 2021 from hwy 16 North thru Wyocena & Pardeeville all the way to County CM will be redone.

The Clerk Laurie Beahm explained the training opportunities that are coming up for the board members including the Land Use Planning Commission as well as the Board of Appeals. If anyone is interested they are to let the board know so we can get them signed up.

The Clerk explained that the Board of Revue was given their paperwork to take their test to recertify. The board will share the DVD so everyone can get the test done so the clerk can report.

The Clerk stated that we are looking for more election workers. We have a couple that have dropped out. Everyone is due to be recertified this year. The training will be this Fall. There are 4 elections coming in 2018.

Joel Burbach asked what the criteria are to be on the Land Use Planning Commission and the Board of Appeals. How is this done and who does it. Charles Corso stated that he has a list of interested people that he talks to and makes the decision.
