OLD BUSINESS

The board reviewed the discussion that Chairman Charles Corso had with Randy Ravenscroft to not exceed \$45,200 for saw cutting and crack filling of the township roads.

Charles Corso stated again that the Wilderness Campground has received their fireworks permit for the 4th of July Celebration.

Charles Corso went over how the property owners need to post their property for No trespassing. 943.13 Statute needs to be on the sign and it needs to be signed by the property owner to make it legal. Sign needs to be at least 11" square.

The board reviewed the training opportunities for the Town Board and Committees.

Charles Corso mentioned that the town needs election workers. If anyone is interested please contact the Clerk.

Traci Wallis was approved by the board to go through the training with the other election workers this Fall.

The board reminded everyone that Associated Appraisers are in the township starting the Reval process.
