**OLD BUSINESS**

Chairman Scott Kempley stated that the Lawn mowing bid for the Town was awarded to Richard Rygiewicz in the amount of \$360 per mow.

The town road tour will be April 17<sup>th</sup>.

The Chairman stated that the Farm Land Preservation Permit Fee is \$400 which was discussed at the last town board meeting.

Scott Kempley let everyone know that the David Labrenz property has been cleaned up and will submit the bill for repayment.

**NEW BUSINESS**

The Chairman stated the new Town board members that were elected. Town Chairman-Scott Kempley, Supervisors-Jan Banicki and Roger Wallis, Town Treasurer-Jean Rataczak and Town Clerk-Laurie Beahm

The board discussed a resolution to take over ownership of 3 of the cemeteries in the township. The Rood, The United Presbyterian and the Hull (Oaklawn) Cemeteries. The clerk read the resolution and the board discussed it. There was a motion by Jan Banicki to approve the resolution second by Roger Wallis.

Scott Kempley gave an update on the refinishing of the wood floors in the town hall. The person doing the work is Tommy Snow with a bid of \$1900.00

The Town board discussed the designation of a spot to put a sand and salt mix for the upcoming winter months for the people in the Town. The placement will be at the East end of the recycle center inside the fence. There will be 1 or 2 – 55 gallon covered drums in the shade by the South Side of the Recycle center. This will be for people in the Township to have it available during the extreme Ice conditions for use.

The Dates for the Open Book will be on Friday April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2019 from 5:00-7:00 p.m. and Board of Review will be on Friday May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2019 from 6:00-8:00 p.m.

The Town board discussed the fireworks permit for Wilderness Campground. Motion by Jan Banicki second by Roger Wallis to approve the permit. Scott Kempley then signed the permit.

The board discussed cleaning up the flower bed in front of the town hall. Omalley and Foss stated that whatever we need for plants would be approximately \$100. The board is looking for volunteers to come and help.

The board reminded people that Road construction will be starting soon in the Montello area.

The highway department is starting to patch the potholes in the Township.

The brushing along 12 miles of roads in the Town has been completed.

The board discussed the upcoming census. It was agreed that maybe someone from the census could come and talk at the June or July meeting.
