

ORDINANCE #18 – ORDINANCE TO DESIGNATE CLASS “B” HIGHWAYS

STATE OF WISCONSIN
Town of Buffalo
Marquette County

The Town Board of the Town of Buffalo, Marquette County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.15 (2) Wis. Stats. to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, designates town highways as class “B” highways in the town as follows:

- A. The following town highways in the Town of Buffalo are designated class “B” highways subject to the weight limits set forth in s. 348.16 (2), Wis. stats., unless increased by town ordinance:

17th Road from County Road O to County Road B

- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above described highways or on before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above noted highways in violation of the weight limits set forth in s. 348.16 (2), Wis. stats. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 348.21 Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on October 13, 2010.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
