

ORDINANCE #18.2 – ORDINANCE TO LOWER SPEED LIMIT ON TOWN HIGHWAYS-**Amended**

STATE OF WISCONSIN
Town of Buffalo
Marquette County

The Town Board of the Town of Buffalo, Marquette County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. Stats. to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town highways in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis Stats. effective December 10, 2012 on certain Town of Buffalo town highways are reduced or modified as follows:

Barry Road reduced to 45 mile per hour
ALL Town of Buffalo roads reduced to 45 mile per hour

- B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5), Wis Stats. the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above described highways or on before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above noted highways in violation of the above noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60 Wis. stats.

This amended ordinance is effective on December 11, 2012.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this amended ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
