

ORDINANCE #18.3 – ORDINANCE TO LOWER SPEED LIMIT ON TOWN RUSTIC ROADS

STATE OF WISCONSIN
Town of Buffalo
Marquette County

The Town Board of the Town of Buffalo, Marquette County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. Stats. to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain Rustic Roads in the town as follows:

- A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. Stats. and s. Trans-RR 1.14 Wisconsin Administrative Code effective June 12, 2012, the speed limit on all on certain Town of Buffalo town highways officially designated as Rustic Roads under s.83.42, Wis. Stats., is established as 35 miles per hour. The following highways in the town have been designated as Rustic Roads are reduced or modified as follows:

14th Road (Sections 20, 29, 30, 31 & 32 of Buffalo Township T.14N-R.10E) approximately 3.3 miles

- B. The town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs on the above described highways or on before the effective date of this ordinance.
- C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above noted highways in violation of the above noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60 Wis. stats.

This ordinance is effective on June 12, 2012.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
